

Frontline Hungary – Team Roles

The following is a rough guide to the team roles in Hungary. Please note the word 'rough'! Each of the team members will have different strengths and weaknesses. Each will also have different expectations and experiences. Putting these all together means you need to be flexible and enthusiastic about joining in wherever you can play a part.

UK Team

- Make contact with all your team prior to the camp
- Make contact with the Hungarian team leader at least once before the camp
- Coordinate with the overall UK leader to check that you have all your resources on the weekend before the camp
- Ensure the team knows who is doing what each day and ensure a fair division of roles
- Specific UK responsibilities (working with the Hungarian team):
 - bible teaching
 - singing
 - English groups
 - end of day review with the children
- Lead the introduction to the camp (Mon) and the parent's meeting on Friday (maybe done by/with the Hungarian team)
- Ensure that the Hungarian team leader has sufficient time to buy more resources
- Together oversee the physical/emotional wellbeing of the UK team and seek to alleviate any problems with the help of Hungarian team leader and other team members
- Initiate and allocate responsibility for the morning devotions and the evening preparation meetings (maybe done by/with the Hungarian team)
- Work with Hungarian team leader and teams to allocate children's presents and prizes at the end of the week
- Lead or allocate responsibility for the summary talk at the parent's meeting

Hungarian Team Leader

At the host church/school

- Be responsible for the money matters with the church/school leadership
- Do the final accounts with the church/school leadership
- Keep a good contact with the helpers from the church/school
- Ensure that all helpers receive a gift on Friday (using the SU money)
- Discuss any problems with the church/school leadership
- Deal with any requests from the church/school leadership

Responsibility for the Hungarian/UK Team

- Ensure group unity
- Oversee the physical/ emotional wellbeing of the Hungarian team and seek to alleviate any problems with the help of the UK team and other team members
- Ensure a fair division of roles amongst the Hungarian team
Specific Hungarian responsibilities (working with the UK team):
drama
discussion groups
games
craft
translation
- Initiate and allocate responsibility for the morning devotions and the evening preparation meetings (maybe done by/with the UK team)

Programme

- Lead the introduction to the camp (Mon) and the parent's meeting on Friday (maybe done by/with the UK team)
- Ensure that the programme runs according to time
- Ensure the continuity of the programme
- Work with the UK team to allocate children's presents and prizes
- Ensure that there are sufficient resources for activities and buy more if necessary

Scripture Union Hungary

- After the camp complete the accounts at SU Hungary
- Ensure all your team sends back the feedback questionnaire after the camp
- Attend the feedback meeting
